

Case Study on Pond

Name of the Group: Poradiha Krishak Sadasya Dol

Address: Poradiha, Chatna, Bankura (West Bengal)

Major change in practice: Re-excavate Pond, Fishery activity and live saving/critical irrigation

Major outcome:

Before re-excavate the pond the villagers were using it's water about 5-7 bigha land for critical irrigation. After re-excavation of pond, there are 37 farmers have irrigated about 63 bigha land and ensured Paddy in 63 Bigha. The approximate production rate of paddy will be 283 quintal and approximate market rate is Rs. 439325/-. Straw will be used as fodder for their livestock.

Fish will be harvested about 2.5 quintal which has a approximate market rate is about Rs. 37500.00.

Corps have been harvested about Rs. 4500.00 from the pond banks.
