Meet Gouri Shee, a resilient woman from Uluberia Block, Howrah. Her husband Rajat is a hardworking farmer, dabbling in paddy and vegetable cultivation, along with fish farming. With a son in college and a daughter employed in a paint factory, their family's income relied heavily on agriculture. However, Gouri faced setbacks with her goat farming due to a lack of knowledge of proper care and vaccination.

Thanks to training from DRCSC ITC MSK and support from the Pashu Sakhi under the 'Livelihood Intensification Programme through the Strengthening Resources project, her goats are thriving now!
